APRIL 8 2024: TIMELINE OF THE ECLIPSE

90 minutes before: Partial eclipse begins

The moment the edge of the moon appears to touch the edge of the sun is called 1st contact.



45 minutes before: Temp

Change & Shadows

Shadow edges that are aligned with the suns

narrowing crescent start to become sharper, edges that lie at right angles remain blurry.

30 minutes before: The Sky Darkens

2/3rds of the Sun is now covered by the moon and the sky becomes dark.

20 Minutes before: Humidity & Wind Change

The Moons shadow causes small changes in wind strength and direction.

5 minutes before: Dark Shadow on Horizon

The moons shadow becomes visible

Seconds before: Corona

The outer part of the Suns atmosphere starts to become visible, dark shadows sweep in and a solar corona ring forms around the dark moon like a jewel.

Just Before: Baily's beads

The final beads of sunlight stream through valleys along the edge of the moon

TOTALITY: The moon covers all of the sun!

WHAT IS APRIL FOOLS DAY?

April Fool's Days origin is unknown but they say it started hundreds of years ago. Some theorize that it dates back to Ancient Rome to a festival called Hilaria where people would dress up in disguises and mock or imitate others. Some think it is similar to Holi, from India where participants throw colored powder and colored water on one another and play tricks on each other. Others think it can be traced back to France when Charles IX decreed the New Year would no longer begin on Easter and those who clung to the old ways were "April Fools."

SALADS & SNACKS TO MAKE & SHARE

CHICKEN & APPLE SALAD

INGREDIENTS:

1/2 cup Kraft mayo 1/4 cup sour cream
1/4 tsp black pepper 2 green onions, sliced

3 cups chopped cooked chicken

1/2 cup chopped walnuts, toasted

2 stalks celery, finely chopped

I apple, chopped



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Mix first 3 ingredients until blended.
- 2. Combine remaining ingredients in large bowl. Add mayo mixture; mix lightly.

HAM & CHEESE WRAP

INGREDIENTS:

1 flour tortilla 1 tbsp real mayo

1 lettuce leaf 1 cheese slice

3 slices shaved ham

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Spread tortilla with mayo.
- 2. Top with lettuce, cheese and ham, roll up tight and enjoy.

BECKYS GREEN PUDDING

INGREDIENTS:

2 cans (14oz) crushed pineapple in juice, undrained

2 pkg Jell-O pistachio Instant Pudding

3 cups thawed cool whip

2 cups mini marshmallows

1 cup chopped pecans

DIRECTIONS:

- Combine first 4 ingredients in large bowl.
- 2. Stir in cool whip.
- 3. Refrigerate 1 hour.

CREAMY EGG SALAD

INGREDIENTS:

Philadelphia chive & onion cream cheese spread

2 tbsp Kraft mayo

2 Claussen whole dill pickles, chopped

8 boiled eggs, chopped

DIRECTIONS:

- Mix cream cheese spread, mayo and pickles in medium bowl.
- 2. Add eggs, mix lightly. Refrigerate several hours until chilled.

CREAMY POTATO SALAD

INGREDIENTS:

1/4 cup Zesty Italian dressing 3 hard boiled eggs, chopped 1 stalk celery, thinly sliced 2 green onions, sliced 1 tbsp chopped fresh dill

6 large potatoes, peeled, cut into 1 inch cubes

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Cook potatoes in boiling water 15 minutes, drain.
- 2. Place warm potatoes in large bowl. Add dressing, toss to coat.
- 3. Add eggs, celery, onions and dill; mix lightly. Stir in mayo. Refrigerate 3 hours or until chilled.

RECIPES TO MAKE & SHARE

ONE DISH CHICKEN BAKE

INGREDIENTS:

1 2/3 cup hot water

1 pkg (6oz) Stove Top Stuffing Mix for Chicken

1 1/2 lb boneless, skinless chicken breast cut into bite size chicken pieces

1 can cream of mushroom soup

1/3 cup sour cream



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Heat oven to 400F.
- 2. Add hot water to stuffing mix, stir just until moistened.
- 3. Place chicken in 13x9 inch baking dish. Mix soup and sour cream until blended; pour over chicken. Top with stuffing.
- 4. Bake 30 min or until chicken is done.

CREAM CHEESE PASTA

INGREDIENTS:

4 cups cherry tomatoes1 tsp dried oregano leaves3 cloves garlic, sliced8 oz cream cheese

1/2 tsp crushed red pepper 3 cups penne pasta

1/4 cup Zesty Italian dressing, divided

2 1/2 cups boiling water

2 tbsp chopped fresh parsley

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Heat oven to 400F.
- 2. Combine tomatoes, garlic, dry seasonings and 2 tbsp dressing in 13x9 inch baking dish sprayed with cooking spray.
- 3. Place cream cheese in center of tomato mixture.
- 4. Bake 30 to 35, stirring after 20 minutes.
- 5. Add pasta, boiling water and remaining dressing to ingredients in baking dish. Use back of spatula to gently press pasta into boiling water so pasta is covered with water. Cover with foil.
- 6. Bake 20 min. Stir and let stand 5 minutes.

STOVE TOP EASY CHICKEN BAKE

INGREDIENTS:

1 cup hot water

1 pkg Stove top stuffing mix for chicken

1 lb chicken breasts cut into pieces

1 can cream of chicken soup

1/3 cup sour cream

3 cups frozen mixed veggies, thawed, drained

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Heat oven to 400F.
- 2. Prepare stuffing as directed on package.
- 3. Combine remaining ingredients in 13x9 inch baking dish sprayed with cooking spray, top with stuffing.
- 4. Bake 30 min or until chicken is done.

VELVEETA CHEESEBURGER MACARONI

INGREDIENTS:

1 lb ground beef 2 3/4 cups water 1/3 cup ketchup 1 tsp onion powder 2 cups elbow macaroni

1/2 Velveeta cut up into cubes

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Brown meat in large skillet, drain.
- 2. Add water, ketchup and onion powder, mix well. Bring to a boil. Stir in macaroni; cover. Simmer on medium-low heat 8 to 10 min or until macaroni is tender, stirring occasionally.
- 3. Stir in Velveeta, cook until melted, stirring occasionally.






